Executive Committee Conference Call Minutes Final

President Jim Miller called the meeting to order at 8:35 PM EST. Present were Scott Rabalais, Sally Dillon, Doug Church, Lynn Hazlewood, Nancy Ridout, Patty Powis, and Tracy Grilli.

- OVER BUDGET ISSUES: The EC discussed the need to prioritize issues regarding over budget requests. We need a plan for facing the issues that come up that may not have been previously budgeted.
- 2. NATIONAL PUBLICATION BID CONSULTANT: The EC discussed the hiring of a consultant to assess incoming bids, and advise about design, long term potential and benefit to USMS. We want her to help sort out the information. Mary Bolster, a USMS member, has unique experience in the field and we shall request an over-budget amount of \$2500 to use for her consulting expertise in narrowing down and evaluating the quality of the bids that are placed before us.
  - It was MSA that we move forward with this project. A proposal will be developed in the next few days that will be submitted to the BOD.
- 3. HIRING OF A WEB DEVELOPER: The Communications Committee has made a recommendation to the EC for the hiring of a web assistant "for a period of six months to help the Webmaster/IT Director cut down on the back log development work for USMS. At the end of four months there would be a decision made by the HOD as to whether to extend the contract." The target date for bringing the person on board is June 1, which requires a waiver of the SWIM Magazine advertising requirement from the BOD. The EC discussed the contract costs (\$35,000 over a 6 month time frame to include expenses for conducting the search, interviews, etc).
  - It was MSA that we accept the Communications Committee's recommendation and forward it on to the BOD for their approval.
  - It was MSA that we waive section 3 (approval of position) and part of V.C (SWIM Magazine requirement) by using the waiver in section IX of PMG. Doug and Patty will work on the exact language of the message to accompany the proposal.

It was MSA to adjourn at 9:55 PM EST.
