

USMS National Championship Coaches Hospitality Policy

Coaches hospitality passes are provided by the meet host to two categories of coaches.

Club Coaches

Coaches of a participating club may be eligible for a hospitality pass based on the number of participants their club has in the meet. In order for a coach to be eligible for hospitality at nationals, he/she must be a current USMS Certified Coach and member in good standing of USMS and should be prepared to provide proof of USMS membership at the meet. Passes are non-transferable and will be available to clubs based on the following participation numbers:

10-29 participants: 1 pass

30-49 participants: up to 2 passes 50+ participants: up to 3 passes

After entries close the USMS Championship Committee will provide the host with the maximum number of potential coaches based on this attendance criteria. Not all clubs will utilize all available passes but this way the host has a worst case scenario to prepare for. This policy will be advertised to all swimmers entered in the meet via STREAMLINES after the entry deadline has passed.

USMS On-Deck Coaches

The USMS Coaches Committee assigns on-deck coaches each day of the meet as a service to all meet participants. These coaches will receive a hospitality pass for the day(s) in which they are assigned to this duty. Individuals who are assigned to this duty may pick up their hospitality pass for their assigned days from the host's designated contact person. Individuals assigned as On-Deck Coaches need not be ASCA certified - the USMS Coaches Committee shall determine their eligibility. The USMS Coaches Committee will provide the total number of On-Deck Coaches for each day of the meet one week prior to the start of the meet.
