USMS International Committee October 20, 1988

Chairman Carolyn Ferris Johnson called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. Committee members and other delegates present attached. Minutes of the 1987 International meeting were approved. Carolyn gave a summary of the many activities the past year, that had occured during coordinating with Indianapolis on the 1989 Pan Pacific Meet, the many problems and emergencies connected with the solicitation and selection of the USMS bidder for the 1992 World Championships, all documented in correspondance to committee members. The selection of Montreal by MSI in override by FINA in awarding the Guam, the championships to Indiana, and the culminating meeting in Brisbane with the MSI vote to hold two simultaneous competitions were explained in detail. Specific details will await final decision by FINA.

Other matters decided this year included simplification of the pool certification ("attested to" by referee) and decision to continue the World Top Ten rather than go to Top Twenty.

PAN PACIFICS: Mel Goldstein made an excellent presentation of detailed plans, schedules and programs for the Pan Pacifics scheduled Oct. 6 - 15, 1989, including a super cadre of supporting volunteers. All aquatic disciplines will be accommodated. An athlete's handbook will be available by Jan. 1. Entry deadline will be mid-July. Expectations are for 4,000 entrants. The Committee pledged its full support. The 1991 Pan-Pacs will be held in Japan.

USMS Representative to FINA: Tina Martin explained reasons for her delay in responding to correspondance from the International Chairman. She stated that she did consider helself a representative of USMS, and supported our stated posture on subjects except when the need for compromise intervened, indicative of the political climate of the FINA organization. Tina indicated she was working on a Procedural Manual for FINA. Carolyn suggested the final draft be shared by the USMS International Committee prior to submission, so any misunderstandings will be eliminated.

Australia Meeting: Tom Boak reported on the many meetings of MSI attended by himself, Carolyn Ferris-Johnson and Kevin Kelly. Kevin was elected Chairman of the Championship Committee; Tom as North American coordinator. He noted support for the two meets in 1992 because of the sheer numbers that will be involved. Both Tom and Kevin plan to be at the FINA meeting in Barcelona where these issues will be decided. He also reported that MSI, in an effort to improve its financial picture, had revised its annual fee from \$100 to \$1,000. Committee moved and passed unanimously.

Fourteen names may be submitted to FINA for consideration as the Masters Committee. USMS nominated Tina Martin, in support of its pledge at the 1987 convention; however, the nomination was rejected 6-1. USMS then nominated June Krauser, who was accepted unanimously. The dilemna must be resolved so as to present a united front.

Time Containment: several proposals were discussed as methods to contain the size of upcoming international meets. Carolyn asked that any members having concrete/constructive ideas should communicate with her immediately.

Travel Agents: after much discussion and exchange of opinions, it was moved that the USMS select one or more official Travel Agents for future travel plans. A subcommittee will be appointed to thoroughly investigate the task. Among those to be solicited will be airlines. Tom Boak suggested a member of the Executive Committee be included on this sub committee.

Definition: Kevin Kelly presented a comprehensive change of the definition of the International Committee to more accurately reflect its charge. Kevin is to convert some of the wording and present it to the legislative committee for consideration.

Meeting adjourned at 3:30 p.m.
