

Meeting was called to order at 1:15 P.M. by Chairman, Rob Copeland.

Dale Petranech (USS LDS Chairman) made a presentation about the USS LDS meeting, held yesterday. The 1990 25K championship will also be a qualifier for the 1990 World Games.

Long Distance Calendar committee report by Dave Gray. Gary McDowell and Dave put together the calendar for the third year. The problem of creating a more complete calendar was discussed, it is the intent of the committee to increase the number of events listed.

Cable swimming guide committee report by Dr. Jim Miller. The latest draft of the guide was distributed to committee members for review. All committee comments will be submitted to the chairman. MSC to send the guide for publication this year, as per 1989 budget.

National Championship packet committee report by Rob Copeland. Progress continues, with regard to this packet's development. An event bid form was distributed for review. An event evaluation form was distributed, reviewed, and will be revised with an evaluation criteria attachment. MSC to include the revised version of the evaluation form in the contracts starting in 1991 as a method of measuring compliance to contractual obligations, and to be used in 1990 used on a trial basis. The event evaluator will continue to be selected by the committee chairman, and the suggestion was made to codify the position of evaluator by a rule change, next year. A sample National Championship contract was given to the committee, the members will review this sample and have recommendation to the chairman by 9/21/89 8:00 P.M., for further discussions on 9/22/89.

The problem regarding verification of times/distances submitted in postal competitions was discussed. It was recommended that rules be proposed next year to address the resolution of this problem..

1990 budget requests will be submitted for calendar production/distribution expenses, championship evaluator reimbursement (up to \$150 per event), and other reoccurring administrative expenses. MSC to allocate funds to establish an inventory of Championship Medals and patches, to be made available, at cost, to the Championship event directors.

MSC to ADD 305.5.5 Complete financial statements shall be forwarded to the Long Distance Swimming Chairman, within 60 days of completion of the event.
