Leo's alternate

The following proposal replaces L-13, L-14, L-16, L-18, and L-20 and removes part of the rationale for proposals L-5 and L-17. Approve L-5 and include the following as part of it. 201.1.2 Annual Membership - Individual membership is for the period January 1 through December 31 of each year. Swimmers applying for membership for the following year on or after November 1 shall be issued a membership card valid from the registration date through December 31 of the following year. Swimmers must affiliate with an LMSC at the time of registration. Swimmers may register unattached or may affiliate with a club that is already registered for the same year for which the swimmer is registering.

201.1.6 C College Club Swimming Co-Membership

A Current individual members of a CCS Club may obtain a USMS Individual comembership which grants them rights to compete in USMS events governed by Parts 1 and 3 and are subject to Part 4.

B USMS individual co-membership is for the period from the date of registration through December 31 following the conclusion of the current CCS membership year.

C USMS individual co-members are not affiliated with an LMSC. The registration of USMS individual co-members shall be administered through the National Office.

D The USMS fee for individual co-membership shall be established by the Board of Directors.

201.2.5 College Club Swimming Club Co-Membership

A Current CCS clubs obtain a USMS club co-membership upon completion of the CCS club registration. A USMS club co-membership grants the club the rights to compete in USMS events governed by Parts 1, and 3 and are subject to Part 4.

B USMS club co-membership is for the period from registration through December 31 following the conclusion of the CCS club membership year.

C USMS club co-members are not affiliated with an LMSC. The registration of USMS club co-members shall be administered through the National Office.

D The USMS fee for club co-membership shall be established by the Board of Directors.

L-19 to read:

201.3.2 In order for a swimmer to compete as a representative of a club, that club must be a member in good standing of an LMSC (except for USMS co-members) and USMS for the year a swimmer is registering.
