Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm Eastern time.

- 1. The previous minutes were approved unanimously.
- 2. The document, "Legislation 101" was presented. The Committee members were agreeable to the basic content of the document but it needed editing. It was suggested that the Committee edit the document during the week rather than spend meeting time doing so. Richard will send out the document to the Committee for suggested edits.
- 3. Article 202.3 was discussed. The question was whether there was a conflict between the first two sentences and if so, did this qualify as emergency legislation. Kathy Casey and MJ Caswell explained the functional details of the rule to the Committee. Patty Miller commented that, in her opinion, there was no conflict between these two sentences because USA Swimming is not a FINA member federation, USAS (US Aquatic Sports) is the FINA member. A motion was made to confirm that the Legislation Committee agreed that there was no conflict between the statements in 202.3. The motion passed unanimously.
