 - a. Welcome and roll call. Quorum present.
- 2. Adoption of Minutes

a. MSA (Doug S., Jen) motion to approve the minutes of the NELMSC board meeting on March 28, 2024.

3. Officer & Committee Reports

- a. See attached written officers' reports.
- b. Board Chair (Jason W.)
 - i. 2024 USMS Annual Meeting (virtual)
 - 1. Budgetary Changes: \$12 per member 2025 then \$10 per member in 2026 and 2027.
 - 2. College Club Swimming (CCS) members are now automatic USMS members (bridge fee is \$0).
 - 3. Beginning with the 2025 membership year, USMS members may change club affiliation three times per year (no more 60-day waiting period). Transferring to Unattached and updating club affiliation while renewing do not count toward the limit.
 - 4. Many NELMSC members received national awards:
 - a. USMS Club of the Year Granite State Penguins
 - b. Ted Hartz Staff Appreciation Award Doug Sayles
 - c. Dot Donnelly Service Award Guy Davis
 - d. Kerry O'Brien Coach's Award Jason Weis, Bill Meier, Ryan Pope, Susan Cooney
 - ii. 2024 USMS Relay (October 18-20 in Houston, TX)
 - 1. Attendees: Jason Weis, Kysa Crusco, Tara Mack, Doug Sayles, Charlotte Brynn, Guy Davis, Bill Meier, Shannon Linsey, Sarah Dombrowski.
 - 2. Kysa, Bill, Charlotte, and Jason are presenting, and Shannon and Sarah are first timers.
 - 3. 2024 focus on Community Building; 2025 Coaching Club Development; 2026 Event Development
- c. Championship Meet Subcommittee (Doug S. for Sue)
 - i. Financial support from USMS for NELMSC-hosted meets may be necessary moving forward and we may require teams to provide volunteers based on the number of swimmers registered.
 - ii. 2024 New England College Club & Masters Swimming Meet at Boston University (November 2)
 - 1. **MSA** (Tracy, Jen) motion to place this CCS-USMS meet under Championship Meet Subcommittee oversight.
 - iii. 2024 Colonies Zone & NELMSC SCM Championship at WPI (December 13-15)
 - 1. NELMSC taking over full meet management from Paul, although required to use WPI staff for timing system.
 - 2. Waiting for WPI AD to sign contract.
 - iv. 2025 NELMSC & Colonies Zone SCY Championship at Harvard (March 15, 21-23 tentative)
 - 1. Still finalizing dates/times and possibility of distance meet or a four-day meet if can't do distance day the weekend prior.
 - 2. Harvard is confirmed for main weekend and if they can't host distance day we will explore BSI, Boston College, or Andover.
 - 3. Rick expects 700 swimmers given upward trajectory from last year.
 - 4. Consensus agreement to also make this year's meet the 2025 Colonies Zone Championship as discussed at the Colonies Zone annual meeting in August.
- d. Communications (Jason W. for Kysa)
 - i. Over 1000+ Instagram followers, opened Flickr account, and brought back Workout Wednesday to Facebook.
 - ii. Kysa presenting at USMS Relay on how clubs/teams can use social media to keep members engaged.
 - iii. Want to return to a quarterly NELMSC e-newsletter but need regular content contributors (perhaps rotate responsibility amongst board members/other volunteers)?
 - iv. NELMSC continues to support Colonies Zone communications by paying to include their additional email addresses in the LMSC's Constant Contact account (Kysa needs to monitor/approve monthly charges and coordinate with Doug S. to delete/remove old contacts to reduce fee).
- e. Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (Jason W. for Laura)

- i. Laura asked to step down from board due to time constraints; Jason W. and Laura to discuss DEI transition plan and identify interim chair to fill Laura's role until next election cycle.
- ii. Jason W. will also confirm whether Laura is still on USMS Diversity & Inclusion Committee could be educational opportunity for interim chair.
- iii. USMS Relay is offering a session by Jeff Cummings on practical ways to implement DEI practices at the grassroots level.

f. Hall of Fame (Tracy)

- i. 2024 NELMSC Awards & Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony had 96 RSVPs and 84 attendees the biggest yet with 24 swimmers attending a workout at WPI coached by Jason beforehand.
- ii. Invited Jessica Reilly from USMS to attend and help present national awards.
- iii. Venue was great and should keep event location centralized for convenience; save the date of September 28, 2025.
- iv. Hall of Fame is asking for \$1,500 from the main NELMSC 2025 budget due to a HOF donation shortfall; will require advance registration for the annual induction reception to cover no-shows moving forward.

g. Awards & Recognition (Jason W. for Tara)

- i. Collected local NELMSC nominations and submitted for national awards terrific recognition across the board in 2024.
- ii. Working with Jessie to get NELMSC website updated with bios and awards from 2024 Hall of Fame.
- iii. Designed and ordered stickers for smaller "shout-out" recognition and going to implement new quarterly awards to highlight local LMSC recognition.
- iv. Discussed Tom Lyndon Award (NEM) vs the NELMSC Distinguished Service Award and whether to combine into one with proposed name of NELMSC Tom Lyndon Distinguished Service Award.
 - 1. Tom Lyndon Award not given annually and has tended to reflect long-time service to NEM; Tracy to provide historical info from NEM site and Jessie to move to LMSC site.
 - 2. For consideration: if two awards are combined, should any of the former LMSC Distinguished Service honorees be *starred as Lyndon Award recipients in retrospect, if warranted? Jason W. to revisit with Tara.

h. Coaches (Jason W. for Emily)

- i. Held several swimmer clinics in VT with Steve Maas and would like to see more coaches clinics but hasn't had bandwidth to develop further; asked to step down and Ryan Pope has agreed to serve as acting coaches chair.
- ii. Interest from USMS to transform Boston Education Weekend's Sunday session into a "super clinic" with more coaches and swimmers. Considerations include pool space and pros/cons of changing the traditional format, which has been well-received over the past decade.
- iii. BSI Wellesley Aquatics Director reached out about possible USMS programming centrally located and plenty of parking might consider this facility as a future clinic venue.

i. Membership (Doug)

- i. 20 clubs and 39 workout groups; membership growing incrementally and have surpassed last year's total NELMSC is doing better than USMS.
- ii. Registration system transition may be reason for drop in self-identified coaching interest; would like to try and promote/recruit more coaches during Education Weekend and also try to certify ALTS instructors.
- iii. Of 2050 NELMSC members, 432 are unattached Doug S. will work with Ryan and Kysa to send targeted communication about the benefits of joining a club/workout group (can promote new USMS independent swimmer initiative "Lanemate" after learning more at Relay).
- iv. In 2022, NELMSC started covering the annual USMS club & workout group renewal fee for programs that have at least five affiliated USMS members (43 club/workout groups were autorenewed for 2025).

j. Officials (Jason W. for Sue)

i. Have solid crew of officials and already secured staff for BU, WPI, and Harvard meets.

- ii. Doug S. to talk to Sue & Ken Galica about developing pipeline for newer officials to gain experience at mini meets first, as championship meets need strong deck official and starter.
- iii. NELMSC is now paying officials out of championship meet budget so no need for separate line item under the officials coordinator's budget.
- iv. Will order 2025 rulebooks for new officials once they're ready and will also offer any of the autorenewed club/workout group contacts whether they would like hard copy vs electronic.

k. Open Water (Gary)

- i. Created new Open Water Series with five swims (Charles River Swim, Against the Tide x 2, Swim with a Mission, Glen Lake) and provided hats for participants who did at least three swims; 197 USMS swimmers did at least one event and 38 people got a hat.
- ii. For 2025: Mashpee June 7, Against the Tide Brewster June 14 (trying to avoid Frogman and Buzzards Bay), Glen Lake "Fangs" (50th anniversary of Jaws) August 17, Charles River TBD; want to start email list for all OW event directors to share calendars and coordinate schedules.
- iii. Doug D would like to suggest OW event in Berkshires since lots of people in region but no swims offered.
- iv. USMS just voted to eliminate OW sanction fees of \$5 per swimmer but will still require OEVT fee for non-USMS members.
- v. Online event registration process would be easier if OEVT were considered an "add on" vs discount but comes down to promoting USMS membership as a benefit rather than a fee.
- vi. Offered OW clinic in NH and had 20-24 attendees with all participants getting 30-day trial USMS membership and a NewWave swim buoy (sponsor): some clinic swimmers also participated in Glen Lake.
- vii. MOWSA is considering clinics too; Charlotte Brynn (VT) and Fred Bartlett (RI) also offer clinics
- viii. USMS Relay is doing a session on charity swims that benefit veteran groups (Swim with Mission and Frogman will be featured)

1. Sanctions (Doug D.)

- i. Offered four additional meets from 2023 including NEM Monster mini meet
- ii. Shamrock meet didn't return but trying to get back for 2025; also trying to revive Simmons meet and possibly combine with LANES.
- iii. Going to see whether Great Barrington/Simon's Rock/Pittsfield would be interested in offering meet in Berkshires.
- iv. Will review meet evaluation form and tweak for next year.

m. Top Ten Recorder (Jason W. for Jason E.)

- i. Business as usual with Top 10 records and keeping USMS database updated; sending reminders to ensure meet directors submit results in correct format.
- ii. USMS won't allow third-party access to records database and Ed Gendreau still maintains NELMSC records on his own site and has historical records that USMS doesn't.
- iii. NELMSC doesn't have any backup for Ed's site and he's the sole keeper of information (which is crucial for Hall of Fame tabulations); Jason W. to follow up with Jason E. about next steps and ask Ed to consider contractual agreement with suggested timeline for website updates.

n. Web Administrator (Jessie)

- i. Working with Doug S. to keep events/calendar up to date and Tracy and Tara on Hall of Fame and Award edits.
- ii. **MSA** (Doug S., Guy) motion to archive NELMSC Twitter account to preserve domain name but focus future social media efforts on Instagram and Facebook.

o. Secretary (Jen)

- i. Keeping minutes of all board meetings and ensuring they are posted on NELMSC and USMS websites.
- ii. Sparse attendance for this 2024 meeting; need to promote annual meeting date sooner through NELSMC newsletter and social media.
- iii. Need to update USMS with new chair contacts for vanity emails (Laura-DEI and Emily-Coaches leaving board).

4. Adoption of Treasurer's Report (David)

a. See attached written treasurer's report.

- b. Have spent down \$15,000 reserve balance from 2023 as planned; income will likely be over \$100,000 so may change our IRS filing this year.
- c. Anyone who earned \$600+ for services rendered will need to complete 1099 form for tax filing.
- d. NEM and Great Bay will receive payouts for new members in September and October but will not request NELMSC assistance moving forward (NEM planning to ask for USMS financial support instead).
- e. Reminder that if any expenses are expected, please notify David in advance to make sure debit card account can cover.
- f. With Guy no longer on the board, Kysa will review our financial records annually to comply with LMSC Standards requirements.
- g. David had bankers read our bylaws in Florida to help provide consistency with NELSMC business operations; would like to remove personal liability and eliminate need for his name on accounts.
- h. Guy believes we should align our legal nomenclature—bylaws and bank accounts—as an easy fix now; Doug S. suggests we discuss further and coordinate through USMS Controller (Gary Keehner).
- i. MSA (Doug S., Alana) motion to change our official name in bylaws to match bank account: United States Masters Swimming Inc. New England Masters Swimming Committee (aka NELMSC) and in Article 13A, to change the official NELMSC address to that of the Treasurer, not Chair.
 - Jennifer and Jason W. to update bylaws with NELMSC nomenclature and legal address as Treasurer; will circulate with final meeting minutes and ensure update version is posted on NELMSC and USMS website.
- j. Going to change budget cycle to full calendar year versus registration year, so 2025 budget includes 12 months plus 3-month bridge from Oct-Dec 2024.
- k. Our bank account has \$55,000 balance currently but need to monitor closely given increased expenses from running events and championship meets.
- Jason W. and Guy suggest sitting down with Dawson/USMS at Relay about proactive budget
 management and possible support from them in the future; per their mandate, NELMSC is trying to spend
 down some of our reserves and provide value to our members.

- a. Mashpee Super Swim Event Development
 - i. Allocate \$5,000 for Mashpee Swim to elevate to a premier USMS & USA-Swimming dual-sanctioned OW festival with long-term goal of eventually hosting as regional championship (USMS would like to see this happen).
 - ii. Cape Cod Firefish USA Swimming Club agreed to submit USA-S sanction application to the New England Swimming LSC; Bill Burnett and Doug S. to serve as co-event directors; will need subcommittee to assist with planning (Alana agreed to help and Doug S. to ask Jason E. and Rick Osterberg from USA Swimming perspective).
 - iii. Doug S. to write event announcement to present to Dawson and Jay for feedback and funding request.
- b. Elevate Boston Education Weekend May 3-4, 2025 as "Super Clinic"
 - i. Need to find pool; consider providing 80% subsidies for NELMSC members.
 - ii. Explore running events at BSI since CRA is interested in running Masters events (unclear whether they are offering 100x100s or One Hour Swim next year).

Current Initiatives

- 1. Since the existence of the NELMSC Hall of Fame in 2008, expenses for all HOF activities were paid for via NELMSC Donations made by members during time of registration. Coaches Chair Report - September 2024


