1. Minutes - The minutes of the last meeting were approved.
2. Budget Report - \$500.00 has been requested.
3. 25 Meter Zone Championships - The meets scheduled in each LMSC are:
  1. Oregon - November 30-December 1, Lincoln City,
  2. Pacific - October 20 (need a different pool, will try to keep the same weekend),
  3. San Diego/Imperial - October 21-28, Carlsbad,
  4. Southern Pacific - December 8-9, SPMA Championships, and
  5. Inland Empire - Schedule not announced.

For ease in compiling the first year's results there will be no LMSC or club scores. Results of each designated meet should be sent to Kathy Casey, preferably on disk. Only the fastest time will be listed in the final results for a swimmer who swims the same event at two of the designated meets.

4. Update on California law regarding coaches - In spring of 1990, California changed the law. Effective January 1, 1991, coaches and instructors must have first aid, CPR, and emergency water certification (17 hours of total training). If there is a lifeguard on deck the coaches don't have to have the training.

5. 1990 - 1991 - Following are deadlines for the coming year:
  - A. Nominations for USMS Officers (and Zone Rep) - February 28,
  - B. Ransom J. Arthur Award - February or March,
  - C. Coach of the Year - July, and
  - D. Bids for 1993 Short Course Nationals - mid-August.

6. Complimentary newsletters - Each LMSC is asked to send a complimentary copy of its newsletter to the chairman and newsletter editor of each LMSC within Oceana as well as Dorothy Donnelly, SWIM magazine, Dan Gruender, etc. Concern for an LMSC on a tight budget led to the following suggestions: sell subscriptions, send the newsletter without results, and consult a list of persons in each LMSC who actually use the complimentary newsletters.

7. Zone Realignment - The majority of Oceana delegates are in favor of the of the realignment plan prepared by the Long Range Planning Committee (Hugh Moore).

8. Proposed Rule and Legislation Changes - were discussed, in particular, the mandatory certification of at least one official at a meet.
