- 4. Update on California law regarding coaches In spring of 1990, California changed the law. Effective January 1, 1991, coaches and instructors must have first aid, CPR, and emergency water certification (17 hours of total training). If there is a lifeguard on deck the coaches don't have to have the training.

 - B. Ransom J. Arthur Award February or March,
 - C. Coach of the Year July, and
