They will be lowering their LMSC fee to \$5, so they are not in favor of the Unified Fee, which would raise the total USMS cost to their membership significantly. <u>Pacific</u> John King: Summary of our November annual meeting: Keynote speaker (Nathan Adrian), recognition of Pacific swimmers USMS and local level was given. Pacific had a relay meet on August 25. Our SCY champs were in April our LCM champs in July. Our Open Water season started in May. The Berryessa 2-mile swim was a National Championship swim. In July Peter introduced the Unified Fee concept. In August, the we voted to be an early adopter of the United Fee concept. Our November Annual meeting will be November 17. Aaron Peirsol will be our key note speaker.
