

What Does It Mean That Standards Are Fixable?

- Annual or One-And-Done tasks: Complete the task and notify LMSC Development Committee/Standards sub-committee
- Ongoing tasks examples:
 - Unregistered swimmer swam in a sanctioned meet: Fix it by figuring out how it happened and how to prevent in the future and report those to LMSC Development/Standards sub-committee
 - Meet announcement doesn't have all required elements: Fix it by including the missing elements or otherwise correcting as appropriate. Send corrected meet announcement to LMSC DC and take steps to ensure the corrected version is used next year.
 - More...

What Does It Mean That Standards Are Fixable?

 Window for required task has closed: Figure out why the task wasn't done and take action, so it is done next time. Submit a summary of these actions to the LMSC Development/Standards sub-committee.

Sanctions Chairs: New Event Standards

-Email rule book links to event directors and meet referees.

- •Template emails are on the USMS Sanction Chairs page.
- •Ask event director and meet referee to confirm receipt
- •Meet referee must also confirm they will brief other officials at the event

-Meet Announcements must have all required elements.

- •Use the Template Meet Announcement as a guide
- •At least two meet announcements from every LMSC will be reviewed
- •If a meet announcement has missing or incorrect info, the host/LMSC will fix as appropriate and repost and save to use next year.
