- 1. New Members Persons wishing to contribute to the rule book project who were added as committee members during the year were Marilyn Fink, Barbara Dunbar, and Maxine Nellen.
- 2. Approval Process The committee was reminded that the Proposed USMS Rule Book could only be presented to the House of Delegates by standing committees. Therefore the rule book had been sent to the committees of jurisdiction prior to Convention. The Rules, Legislation, and Long Distance Committees will make recommendations to the House of Delegates regarding the rule book.
 - 3. Budget Request Two budget requests were presented.
 - A. If the rule book is approved and the committee continues its work for another year \$560.00 in addition to a \$6000.00 inventory purchase request for publishing and mailing. Income projection for the year was \$6600.00. Lucy Johnson advised the committee that changes had been made in some of those figures by the Finance Committee.
 - B. If the rule book is not approved and the committee continues the project work for another year \$1200.00.

The committee voted to approve the budget request.

4. **Bids** - Six bid requests were sent out. One bid was submitted by Gene Donner of Southtown Forms & Systems (see attached bid). The other potential bidders were asked to submit their bids even though they indicated their bids would be high.

The committee voted to recommend acceptance of the bid from Southtown Forms and Systems for publication of the rule book and secure at least two more bids to comply with the Finance Committee requirements.

A. Contract - Legal Counsel has indicated that a contract would be necessary for publication of the rule book.

The committee voted to delegate the details of the contract to the committee chairperson, Legal Counsel, and the selected printer.

- 5. The Rule Book Itself
- A. Cover The proposed cover was presented by designer Kerry O'Brien. There was considerable discussion.

The committee voted to accept the cover as proposed.

The committee expressed its gratitude to Kerry O'Brien for his diligent work on the cover design.

B. Title - The committee voted to use a shorter title on the cover (see below) and a complete title on the title page.

C. Ads - Mary Lee Watson indicated that there are companies possibly interested in putting ads in the Proposed USMS Rule Book.

The committee voted to direct the Marketing Committee to solicit ads for the inside front cover, the inside back cover, the outside back cover, and black and white ads on additional back pages as necessary (rather than throughout the rule book) with those companies/persons at least covering the cost of printing those ads in the rule book.

D. Indexing - The use of tabs or colored pages was discussed.

The committee voted to put the part number in the upper outside corner of each page in bold face type (all capitals) the size of "ARTICLE 101: INDIVIDUAL STROKES AND RELAYS" on the middle of page 15, Proposed USMS Rule Book, July 1988 version.

E. Appendices

1. Records - The committee voted to include all courses (short course yards, short course meters, and long course meters) on all levels (American, open, and world), times only rather than names and/or country, including the dates those records were compiled in each title. Long Distance records will also be included in the Records Appendix.

* The committee was complimented on the inclusion of the adapted swimming quidelines. Sports Medicine will be asked to develop quidelines for litts and transfers in and our of the water.

The committee also voted to ask USS to publish the most current available Masters records in the next USS Rule Book.

- 2. Suggestions for Warmups The committee voted to include a condensed version of "Suggestions for Warmups" contingent upon the approval of the Sports Medicine Committee and Legal Counsel.
- 3. USS/USMS Differences. The committee voted to include an appendix listing the USS/USMS rule differences and ask USS if they would include that appendix in their rule book along with information for ordering the USMS Rule Book. June Krauser agreed to review this appendix before publication.
- 4. Transfer/change of address form The committee voted not to include this information in the appendices due to the size of the form in the rule book and the potential need to tear it out of the rule book.
- 5. Directory of LMSC Chairpersons There was discussion regarding the order of the information. the committee voted to leave the order as currently printed in the July version.
- F. Copyright The question of copyrighting the USMS Rule Book was brought up considering that many of the rules quoted are from the USS Rule Book which is copyrighted. Ted Haartz agreed to inquire of USS regarding copyrighting the USMS Rule Book.

The committee voted to copyright the USMS Rule Book pending discussion/approval from USS.

6. Number to Order if Approved - About 600 rule books are needed for USMS registered clubs, the Board of Directors, and LMSC Registrars. Through the House of Delegates each LMSC will be asked to estimate how many rule books swimmers/officials in their area might order.

Ted Haartz informed the committee that USS is currently committed to its policy of including USMS in the USS Rule Book at no charge.

The committee voted to recommend an order of 1200 rule books and a charge of \$6.00 per rule book (to include mailing and handling).

- 7. Size of Book and Binding The committee voted to accept the size and binding as specified in the bid specifications.
- 8. Ordering Information The committee voted to include an order form for the USMS Rule Book in the USMS Newsletter,

Swim-Master, and SWIM Magazine as well as a line of ordering information on USMS pages in the USS Rule Book and on the title page of the USMS Rule Book ("additional copies available from the National Office..").

- 8. Errors The committee was reminded to submit any errors found to the chairperson at this Convention. Content issues need to be discussed with the committees of jurisdiction.
- 9. Future of the Committee The committee voted to ask President Tom Boak to continue the committee for another year to handle the details of publication and ongoing work on grammar, punctuation, spelling, and clarity.

10. Special Considerations -

- A. Dedication The committee voted by acclamation to dedicate the 1989 USMS Rule Book to June Krauser for all her years of dedication to USMS rules. A front page will be devoted to this purpose.
- B. Credits The committee voted to give editorial credit on the title page to Kathrine Casey, Gail Dummer, and Christine M. Martin.
- 14. Recommendation The committee voted to recommend publication of the USMS Rule Book (July version as corrected at this Convention to include Rule, Legislation, and Long Distance Rule changes passed at this Convention) for 1989.
