Our next item of business was planning our USMS pages for the next 6 issues and chaired by Nancy Ridout. Many suggestions were offered. The Fitness Committee will try to contribute fitness-oriented articles regularly. Other committee chairmen will continue to be called upon to offer articles within their expertise. The value of a President's and Executive Secretary's column in each issue was discussed and it was proposed that this space could also be used to explain our decision-making processes to our members, such as how a rule is adopted, why we have certain policies and procedures.

Phil Whitten, the Editor of SWIM, reported steady improvement in the relationship between USMS and SWIM and that the SWIM editors are out to proselytize about swimming. Phil mentioned a variety of future topics relating to travel, vacation and training.

Tom Lyndon concluded the agenda with a discussion of the operation of SWIM, his views on USMS options and articles outside the field of horizontal swimming. Dick Deal responded that SWIM tries to be balanced and weigh the needs of all prospective readers and subscribers.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:30pm.
