Motion made, seconded and passed: Establish a new policy that all National and World Championship meets have a Record Representative present to verify any American National Records that are set. (All present TXXX Top Ten from LMSC also voted on each issue as presented) Motion also passed all LMSC TT.

It was agreed, after a detailed discussion, that we cannot as yet set any kind of standards for time to help LMSC TT plan their top ten submissions. The general feeling was that we should do everything we can to encourage LMSC*s to produce their own top ten or top five regardless of its purpose of submission to Natl TT.

KKKK

Enid reported that Carolyn Ferris-Johnson had agreed to replace Bert Petersen as National Relay Recorder. In the discussion to add the 400 & 800 meter and yard relays the vote was 3 to 3. Enid then polled the LMSC TT and, based on their vote, cast the deciding vote to veto this rule. The motion was then resubmitted for th 400's only and the vote passed for inclusion of these relays.

It was moved and passed by all, unanimously, to insist that all relays which wish splits to be included in TT or relays must be on USMS relay cards specially designed for that purpose. Nancy Ridout will head the committee to design and produce this card. A sample will be sent to each LMSC for them to reproduce for their own needs and arrangements will be made for Gene Donner to have them available if they wish to purchase from him. It was also agreed to encourage all LMSCs to use this card for all relays to help in more accurate reporting of names and ages.

XXXXXXX

It was moved and passed to produce reduced size, but legible copies of TT individual results and relays for each LMSC Chairman and Registrar. Elfriede Rogers was appointed to prepare the copy which will be sent to the National Office for distribution. If approved by the House of Delegates the upcoming LC TT would be so distributed. This is not intended to replace any publication in our present magazines.

MSR 13-14-15-16=17 were approved as amended and voted to the Rules committee, voting down those they did and accepting the ones they passed. MSR 30 was voted down by both the committee and the Top Ten LMSCs.

A housekeeping revision of p 155 "F", p. 161 "I" p 162 "K" was approved and will be submitted to the Rules committee. The purpose of these changes are simply to me-arrange and clarify present rules in a more logical manner.
