The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am

- 1. A brief introduction of attendees followed by the LMSC chairs giving an update on their LMSC happenings.
- 2. Katie McClelland, North Texas LMSC, presented the 2009 SCY Championship Zone Bid to the committee. MSA to approve the meet on March 27-29, 2009.
- 3. With respect to the administration of the meet, there was a MSA to run the heats for the distance events slowest to fastest similar to the format of the pre-seeded events.
- 4. Tom Boak presented a bid for the 2009 LCM Championship to the committee. The bid, which includes a \$20 surcharge and \$4/event fee was MSA.
- 5. The tentative calendar was MSA. Jane Masters, Border LMSC, noted that the area of Midland may add a meet and Susan Ingram noted that the South Texas LMSC may host a October SCY meet either October 16th or 23rd, 2008. Additionally, Katie McClelland, North Texas, mentioned her LMSC may host a summer LCM meet but no date is available as of yet.
- 6. Discussion surrounding the possibility of hosting a SCM Zone Championship was discussed and it was determined that we will continue to explore this idea and work with all LMSC's regarding potential funding to make a meet successful. The idea of eliminating awards to cut down expenses was introduced.
- 7. A MSA for a new Zone policy is as follows: Zone Meet records may only be set in the specific individual event swam for that particular stroke and distance.
- 8. A MSA was made to appoint Susan Ingram, SC Zone Meet Records Chairman. She will maintain the Zone Meet records for both SCY and LCM.
- 9. Susan Ingram was congratulated as being awarded USMS Coach of the Year.
- 10. After discussion with both At-Large BOD candidates within the SC Zone, a MSA was made to select one candidate to present to the HOD. As a result of the secret ballot, Don Mehl will be presented to the HOD as the At-Large BOD candidate from the SC Zone.
